### **Instructional Update**

Please note that due to the latest update with COVID 19 we will be extending our online instruction for all grade levels.

- KG 12<sup>th</sup> Grade students will continue with online instruction through Friday, January 15<sup>th</sup>.

- 7<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> Grade students will remain on online instruction until further notice.

## **Parent Teacher Conference (PTC)**

## **Important FLVS Proof of Residency Reminder**

All secondary students who are registered for classes are required to upload proof of residency document to their FLVS account within 30 days of requesting a course. Students will receive reminders and instructions upon log in. Please see below for a list of approved proof of residency documents. Only one document from the list needs to be provided.

- Gas, water, sewage, electric, or home/cellular telephone bill
- Rent receipt with name of lessee and contact information
- Lease agreement with name of lessee and contact information
- Mortgage statement or mortgage commitment
- Home purchase contract, including specified closing date, with copy of deed to be provided within 60 days of closing date
- Property tax statement
- Automobile insurance statement
- Current Florida driver's license or Florida identification card belonging to the parent listed on the student's account
- Bank Account statement

#### Access to Parent Portal

All parents are asked to kindly log into their Parent Portal to ensure that they have access. If you need assistance with your username or password reset please call our main office at 813-628-0007 x501 or send us an email at <a href="mailto:frontdesk@hifzacademy.org">frontdesk@hifzacademy.org</a>. You will need to access your parent portal to complete the COVID Response Form daily for your child. Once logged into the parent portal, click on **WEB FORMS**, then click on **COVID RESPONSE FORM - FAMILY** link.

#### **NEW Dismissal Procedure**

Families who have not yet received their assigned family dismissal number may pick it up from our main office. Please see Sr. Olena or Sr. Rafeena. To make dismissal more efficient all families must have their family number clearly displayed on the vehicle dashboard. If another authorized person will be picking up your child he/she must have the family number. If not, they must obtain the family number from our front office after they have been verified as an

authorized pick-up person for the family. You can add or remove pick-up person by accessing our parent poral at any time.

### **National School Lunch Program (NSLP)**

Alhamdulillah our school is now a qualified Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2019-2020. This means that our school can provide healthy breakfast and lunch each day at no charge for ALL students. Please see attached detailed letter regarding our CEP announcement.

#### **Uniform and Dress Code**

Please note that upon return to school on Monday, Jan. 18<sup>th</sup> all students must be in required uniform attire. Please review the Uniform & Dress Code details, which can be found in our parent portal under RESOURCES, to ensure that the appropriate attire and color scheme are implemented. There has been a color change with the secondary student to include Navy-Blue PE tops for both male and female students.

- Please write your child's name on the inside tag of all outer garments (Sweater, jacket, hats, scarf etc.).
- Please send your child with a CLEAN MASK daily and place an extra in their bag.

#### Absentee

### **Health & Safety**

For the health and safety of everyone, please KEEP SICK children at home. The purpose of completing the COVID Form daily is to bring your attention to your child's health. If your child was running a fever the night before, please do not send them to school the next day. Student should be fever free for at least 48 hours and have clearance from a doctor before returning to school.

Parents please pay attention to the items below.

- Avoid gathering (especially indoors), rethink your travel plans if any, stay home and get tested if you are feeling
  ill. We encourage you to wash your hands and keep 6 ft distance for the safety of your families and loved ones.
- Complete the online COVID form daily for your child(ren) who are on campus. If you fail to complete this form, your child will not be allowed to attend class until the form has been completed.
- Send clean MASKS daily with your child. Some students are coming in with dirty masks. Parents are encouraged to purchase the cloth masks that can be washed and worn again.
- A refillable water bottle is required daily as the children are now actively playing outside and going out for PE.
- Kindly send a sweater with your child daily and put his/her name on the inner tag.
- Please take extra precautions as it is the Flu/Cold season.
