NEW Dismissal Procedure

Alhamdulillah, with the help of our staff and community volunteers our dismissal has been going well. Effective immediately, for the safety of all our children, all families going through the dismissal drive through MUST have their car tag displayed in order to pick up their child. If you do not have your family dismissal number to display, you must park your car and walk into the office until we can verify your family number. If someone other than the person on file will be picking up your child, please be sure to add that person under authorized pick-up on to your parent portal in advance. Additionally, your family dismissal number must also be given to that person. Students will not be dismissed if the person picking them up do not have a number and the person is not listed on our system as a pick-up person. If you or your student misplaced their tag, there will be a \$10.00 replacement fee for the family car tag and or the student tag.

Health Screening

Hearing Screening (KG, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 6th & 7th) will be done on campus on **Friday, November 20th** at 9 AM by Sertoma Speech & Hearing Foundation for all students in the above grades who have not yet provided proof that this was done by their pediatrician during their well visit check.
